



EVEQUE Hot Tub Maintenance & Safety Advice

Please follow the advice below to ensure safe use and prolonged life of your cover.

Our covers are manufactured in the UK using premium materials which provide protection all year round for efficient running of your hot tub. Maintaining your hot tub cover is easy and cleaning your cover once every 1-3 months will prolong its life considerably. The Sun's UV rays, rain, snow and ice can adversely affect your hot tub cover; proper maintenance will help your hot tub cover last many years. Abrasive cleaners will strip the vinyl causing it to fade, crack and deteriorate. It is advised to use products specifically designed for cleaning hot tub covers. Stay away from oil based 'protectants', these are extremely damaging as they amplify the sun's rays and can damage the vinyl material.

SAFETY

1. **DO NOT SIT / STAND** or **LAY** on your hot tub cover. They are not designed to support weight.
2. **KEEP CHILDREN AWAY** – Do not allow children to play under the cover, children or objects **CANNOT BE SEEN** under cover.
3. Remove cover **COMPLETELY** before entering your hot tub. Entrapment is **POSSIBLE**.
4. **UNSECURED** or **INADEQUATELY SECURED** covers are a **HAZARD**. Remember to lock down your cover when not in use.
5. Always break the vacuum seal by pushing the corner of the hot tub cover up. Using the handles will cause them to break.
6. Handles are **NOT** designed for the carrying or removal of the cover from the hot tub.
7. **DO NOT** drag your hot cover along the ground.
8. When the spa is in use, the cover should be placed in a clean, dry area, otherwise it can pick up **DIRT** and **BACTERIA**. A cover lifter is useful for ensuring that the cover does **NOT** come in to contact with the ground.
9. When shocking the hot tub, always leave the **COVER OFF** for around 30 minutes. This will prevent a build-up of chemical smells and protect the underside of your cover. It is very important to take the whole cover off, **DO NOT** just flip one side open.
10. Failure to follow these instructions may result in **INJURY** to persons or **DAMAGE** to your cover.
